1 Vancouver - BC Ferries - Butchart Gardens - Inner Harbour

Get on the BC Ferries from Tsawwassen to Swartz Bay and arrive at the capital of BC - Victoria. Pass by the Gate of Harmonious at Canada's oldest Chinatown. Visit the BC Legislative Buildings, Confederation Gardens Court, Thunderbird Park, Beacon Hill Park and Mile "0" of Trans-Canada Highway. Explore more of Victoria's Inner Harbour with our recommend activities (optional): Carriage tour around the harbour, enjoy a premium afternoon tea at Empress Hotel (adult \$95 / child [11yrs&under] \$50, tax included) OR visit the Royal BC Museum. Visit the famous Butchart Gardens (adm included) for splendid view of the garden of flowers and trees. Stay overnight in Victoria. Optional upgrade your stay at the Fairmont Empress.

2 Victoria - Hatley Castle - Goldstream Provincial Park - Duncan - Chemainus - Nanaimo - Vancouver

Proceed to Hatley Castle at Royal Roads University and Goldstream Provincial Park to discover heritage and nature wonders. Take a leisure stroll under the canopy of towering trees, and pass the giant Western Red Cedar over 600 years old. Visit Duncan, the City of Totems, which has more than 80 totem poles around the entire town. Head to Chemainus. Explore the outdoor murals on the street, which depict the cultural development and history. Arrive at Nanaimo by late afternoon and return to Vancouver by BC Ferry.
